Library and Information Services

Library section of IICT is now in a position to provide relevant & necessary information for Carpet & Textile Industry. The IICT library uses Alice for window software package, which is an integrated multi-user library management system that supports all in-house operations of the library. The Alice for window consists of modules on acquisition, cataloguing, circulation, serials, articles indexing and OPAC. Retrospective conversion of bibliographic records has been completed and 10,000 bibliographic records of books available in the library can now be accessed through the Alice for window OPAC. The database of books available in the library is being updated on day-to-day basis with details of recently acquired books, Records of all the library patrons have also been created in the Alice for window package. The editing and updating activities are in progress.

The Alice for window package has been successfully implemented for the circulation activities, initially for faculty and staff. All faculty and staff members are being migrated to the new computerized circulation system. The package has also been implemented for acquisition and Cataloguing activities.

Industry members from Industry may approach through AICMA/CEPC and take benefit of the library. Any industries can enroll them as a member of the IICT library.

1. New Additions

- a) In order to cater to the specific needs of IICT library members the subscription of Textile and related journals has been increased. In addition library received 24 journals.
- b) To promote the specific needs of members & the number of publication acquired through library has been increased.
- c) Every year according the budget new books were purchased and added to our records.

2. Center for Academic Partnership

IICT has further promoted its academic interaction with industries and academic institutions by encouraging its library to be "Center for Academic Partnership".

3. Extended Services

The library remains open on every day (accept Sunday's & Holidays) to provide services to its members and the students of different short terms courses conducted by IICT.
